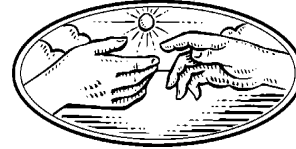

Power-Up Self Defense for Women

Power Up is a non-profit organization that provides self defense classes to women - and they are coming to Clinton on March 2 and 4 at the Clinton United Methodist Church. This is an 8-hour course, with the class times from 6:00 to 10:00 p.m. each evening. It is important that you attend both nights of class. The cost is \$25.00 per participant and is offered to women ages 14 and up. There will be two instructors available both nights, with the lead instructor being Lt. Sonny Lynch of the Clinton Police Department. Sarah Fuehring of Concordia will be the second instructor. The class is limited to 20 participants. Registration forms are available in our church office or at the Clinton Police Department. Registration deadline is February 22.

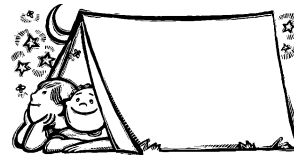
Let's Talk About Summer Church Camp
