May has been designated as Christian Home Month. To honor this designation and our family life we will have home life as the theme for the month. Pray for our families and encourage happy, safe and loving homes.



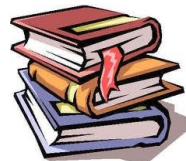
 We thank God for the life among us of Marlene Shoemaker, a member of this church since 2010. Our love and sympathy to her husband Bob on her death April 27.
