## Red Bird Cardinal Singers Concert

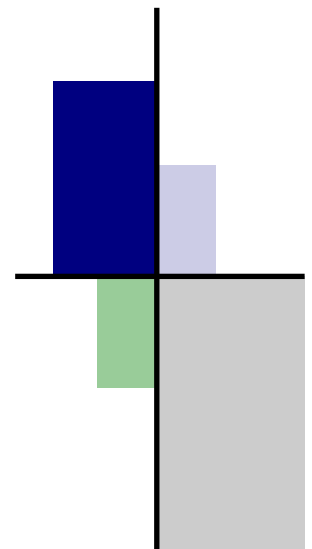
