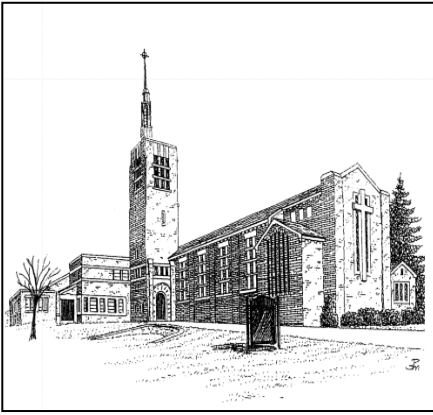


Tower Views
