### Angelus Choir

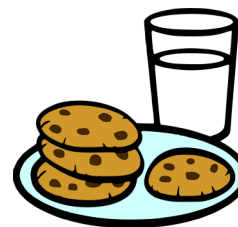


Angelus Choir will be starting September 5th—First thru 5th graders meet on Wednesdays at 3:30 for music with

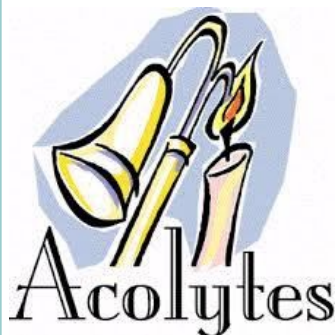
1st Reading: Isaiah 35:4-7
