Cyclone Dineo Hit Mozambique

A devastating cyclone has hit our Methodist brothers and sisters in southern Mozambique. Many of our Methodist ministries were at the center of the storm – including the Cambine Mission Station (orphanage, seminary, agriculture center), the Chicuque Rural Hospital and the Hanhane Women's Shelter. This area is the heart of Methodism in Mozambique. In addition, an estimated 120,000 families have lost their homes and approximately 100 churches and parsonages were in the direct path of the storm. Seven people were killed by the storm, four of those were connected to the United Methodist Church. Through our Mozambique Initiative, the Missouri Annual Conference is uniquely positioned to respond to Cyclone Dineo. Donations will be used to respond to emergency needs for shelter and food, in addition to repairing and rebuilding church structures.
