Daily Bible reading & Prayer

SUNDAY: Mark 4: 40--5:8

FRIDAY: Exodus 20: 8-11

Pray about why God was so intentional about “Sabbath” time.

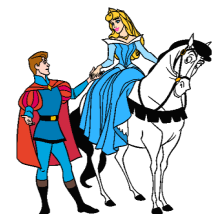
SATURDAY: Luke 4: 14-21
