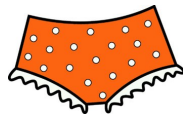

Our church was represented at the recent Missouri United Methodist Annual Conference by Tom Griffiths and Brad Reed. Some of the highlights included:

- Celebrating 20 years of partnership by Missouri United Methodists with the United Methodist Church in Mozambique. Over those 20 years conference has provided over \$8 million for churches, wells, seminary scholarships and other projects.
- Introducing a new mission emphasis in Puerto Rico to help rebuild after the hurricane. The efforts of Missouri United Methodists will be focused on the island of Vieques.
- Adopting a new set of missional goals for the conference that focus on:
 - Developing New Missional Leaders.
 - Creating New Places for New People.
 - Offering a Pathway Out of Poverty through Childhood Literacy.
- Celebrating that we have started 30 new churches in Missouri in the past 10 years.
- Sharing that we had over 4,500 students participate in our various camping programs in 2017.

Of special interest to our church, Casey Henry, who was previously part of our congregation, was commissioned into pastoral ministry as a Provisional Elder during the Celebration of Ministry. Casey serves as the pastor of Hope UMC in Lone Jack.

We are blessed to be part of one of the strongest conferences in the United Methodist Church!
