### Mid-Week Lenten Service

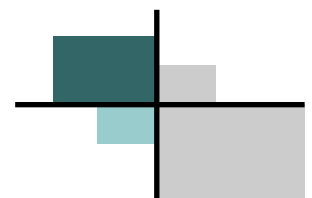
Everyone is invited to share in special Lenten mid-week services on Wednesdays at noon. These 30 minute services each include the celebration of Holy
