Malaria: Fact Sheet

Fact: In 2010, there were an estimated 216 million cases of malaria causing 655,00 deaths, mostly among African children younger than five.
Fact: Every 60 seconds, malaria claims an innocent life in Africa.
Fact: Malaria is preventable and curable. Increased malaria prevention and control measures are dramatically reducing the malaria burden in many places.
Prior to 1951, malaria was a serious public health problem in the United States – in fact, it led to the creation of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). A comprehensive effort from 1947 – 1951 virtually eradicated malaria in the US.

Imagine No Malaria is an extraordinary effort of the people of the United Methodist Church, putting our faith into action to end preventable deaths by malaria in Africa, especially the death of a child or mother.

Our church has set a goal to raise \$10,000 to assist in this effort. To kick off this campaign, the Angelus choir has been collecting coins to place in their organ pipe to purchase 10 mosquito nets at \$10.00 each. Thus far, they have collected 73.00. We will also be having a Lord's Acre sale in conjunction with the city-wide garage sale on April 11 and 12. As part of this, the choir will also be having a bake sale. If you have items you would like to donate, you can bring them to the church and place them in the racket ball room. Or if you have items but can't get them to the church just call the church office, and they will see that they get picked up. What a great way to regift some of those things you've been wanting to find a home for.
