



Unfortunately, our sisters and brothers in our covenant church in Mongue, Mozambique are not so blessed. Their water source is six miles from their village. The women make that trek every day to bring water for their families. And that water they bring back isn't safe or clean. As a result, water-borne illnesses are a constant threat – especially to the children.

But we have the opportunity to change all of that. We have the opportunity to provide two wells that will supply clean, safe water right near their churches. And we're almost there. We've already raised over \$20,000 toward our goal of \$25,200 to provide two wells for the people of Mongue. Thank you for all your generosity to get us this far – and thank you in advance for your generosity to complete this project. I know we will!

And thank you to everyone who provided socks for our students in need here in Clinton. We collected 833 pair!

Our goal is to raise the remaining funds - \$4,500 – during the month of June. The gift of clean, safe water is one of the greatest gifts we can give the people of Mongue.
