Cherub Choir: young children sing each Sunday morning for Sunday School Class. We will be hearing them sing for church soon.

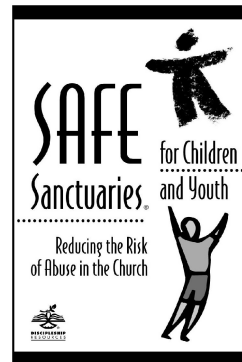
